

CHAPTER V CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

A. Conclusions

Based on the results of research conducted by researcher through data collection and data analysis related to “slang language used by *anak jaksel* to enrich vocabulary: a descriptive analysis”, this research could be concluded as follows:

1. Based on data obtained by researcher, there were five types of slang found in posts on the @kampuninggrism Instagram account, namely compounding (20,8%), blending (20,8%), clipping (16,7%), derivation or affixation (12,5%), and acronyms (29,2%). Each type of slang contained several words that have been found by researcher on the Instagram account, there were 5 words in the form of compounding: couple goals, toxic relationship, trust issue, bad egg, smart cookie; 5 words of blending: hangry, brunch, frenemy, staycation, bestie; 4 words of clipping: ship, fit, sus, tho, 3 words of derivation or affixation: careless, effortless, misunderstand; and 7 words of acronyms: G5!, F2F, YOLO, OIC, XOXO, LMAO, FYI; so the total number of words founded by the researcher was 24 words.
2. The following were the trending slang words “anak jaksel” along with their real meaning in Indonesian used by teenagers in daily communication: type of compounding slang contained 5 words namely couple goals (*pasangan yang jadi panutan*), toxic relationship (*hubungan tidak sehat*), trust issue (*sulit percaya*), bad egg (*orang jahat*), smart cookie (*orang pintar*); type of blending slang contained 5 words namely hangry (*marah dan lapar*), brunch (*makan menjelang siang*), frenemy (*saingan*), staycation (*liburan di hotel*), bestie (*teman dekat*); type of clipping slang contained 4 words namely ship (*hubungan*), fit (*baju*), sus (*curiga*), tho (*sih*); type of derivation or affixation slang contained 3 words namely careless (*ceroboh*), effortless (*mudah*), misunderstand (*salah paham*); type of acronyms slang contained 7 words G5! (*tos!*), F2F (*berhadapan*), YOLO (*hidup cuma sekali*), OIC (*aku*

paham), XOXO (*peluk cium*), LMAO (*ngakak banget*), FYI (*info tambahan*).

B. Recommendations

Based on the research that has been carried out, researcher need to provide constructive suggestions to improve and develop English language skills by enriching vocabulary through slang used by young people, such as the *anak jaksel* trend. Researcher hope that future research can be even better than previous research. So in this case the researcher relies on several suggestions as follows:

1. English Teachers

This research provides examples and strategies related to learning methods that can be used in the teaching and learning process. Teachers can use this research as a reference to complete learning materials and can also look for new learning materials from the @kampunginggrism Instagram account, such as providing quizzes about missing song lyrics, grammar quizzes, slang vocabulary quizzes, and etc. With the aim that students do not quickly get bored while studying in class.

2. Students

Learning unique English slang words will bring important value in achieving English language skills, especially in communication skills, whether communicating orally or in writing. Therefore, students must improve their understanding of English, both formal and non-formal.

3. Researchers

This research can be used as a reference or information for further research. The researcher hopes that future researchers who use the same topic as this research can develop more related to slang language research, by using different theories, different social media as data, and improving the methods used in slang language research. Hopefully this research can contribute to the progress of slang language research in the future.
